Monday: Roping

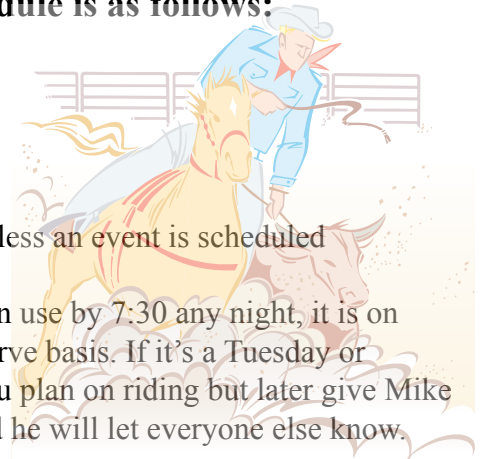
Tuesday: Family
